- 8. Have you recently reviewed the ENAO website, including the LEAD roles & responsibilities?
- 9. What are your suggestions & desires of ways for ENAO to better serve the membership?
- 10. What is your personal vision for ENAO in the future?
- 11. What is your understanding of the ENAO NENA connection?
- A. ENAO BOD meetings & AGM attendance are mandatory & require a working Friday evening plus 2 full meeting days on Saturday & Sunday, twice each year (spring, fall).
 - (Special emergency exemptions may be granted)
- B. Family & employer must be supportive of necessary time away and the travel involved, for ENAO BOD participation and responsibilities.
- C. ENAO pays hotel room, meals (breakfast, lunch, working dinner), per diem @ \$100.00 per day for 1 travel day & 2 meeting days, any WIFI costs, and reimburses travel expenses to attend ENAO BOD / AGM meetings or working groups to represent ENAO.
- D. Participation on the ENAO BOD counts as 25 education hours towards CNA certification.
- E. All ENAO BOD members must adhere to Canada's privacy laws and commit to maintaining confidentiality regarding information & discussions within the BOD.
- F. ENAO BOD meetings' minutes may contain identified In Camera sessions, as they become public documents, following review & approval by the BOD.
- G. ENAO BOD members are serving the provincial ENAO membership, not their local hospital or community.
- H. ENAO BOD members cannot publicly support a particular political party. Any voiced/written thoughts or opinions must clearly identify the source as personal, NOT on behalf of ENAO.
- I. All requests from the press must be referred to the entire ENAO BOD for discussion, due diligence and ENAO's official response.
